WHEREAS The District Council of South Cambridgeshire (hereinafter called "the Council") are the appropriate local planning authority for the area of South Cambridgeshire and are satisfied that it is expedient that certain development permitted by the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1973^{as amended} (hereinafter called "the Order") should not be carried out unless planning permission is granted on an application in that behalf

NOW THE COUNCIL HEREBY DIRECT under Article 4 of the Order as follows:-

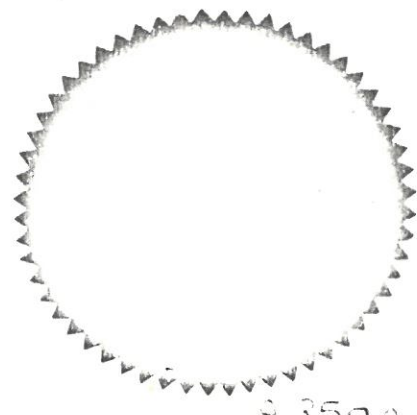
1. The permission granted by Article 3 of the Order shall not apply to development described in Schedule 1 of this Direction on the land described in Schedule 2 of this Direction

~~2. In this Direction the expressions "development", "planning permission", "erection" and "land" have the meanings assigned to them by Section 293 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 and the Interpretation Act 1989 shall apply to the interpretation of this Direction as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament~~

3. This Direction may be cited as the Town and Country Planning South Cambridgeshire (Great Chishill) Direction 1975 ~~and shall become effective from the date of approval by the Secretary of State.~~
