TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (SOUTH CAMBRIDGESHIRE) CALDECOTE AND TOFT DIRECTION 1983

## WHEREAS: -

- The South Cambridgeshire District Council (hereinafter called "the Council") are the Local Planning Authority for South Cambridgeshire\_
- The Council are satisfied that it is expedient that development of the description 2. set out in the First Schedule hereto should not be carried out on the land shown edged blue and edged red on the plan annexed to this Order and more particularly described in the Second Schedule hereto, unless permission therefor is granted on application made under the Town and Country Planning General Development Orders1977 to 1981\_

## NOW THEREFORE

the Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by Article 4 of the Town and Country General Development Orders 1977 to 1981 hereby direct that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said-Order shall not apply to development of the said land of the description set out in the First Schedule hereto.

## FIRST SCHEDULE

The use of the land for the purpose of the racing of mechanical vehicles including cars and motor cycles and including grass track racing, motor vehicle rallies (including car, motor cycle, locomotive, steam and other engine rallies) and scrambling, markets, car boot sales, popular music festivals, public dancing, public music, public contests, public exhibitions, the siting of tents or tenting rally on no more than fourteen days in total in any calendar year and the erection or placing of moveable structures on the land for the purposes of that use being development comprised within Class IV(2) referred to in Schedule 1 of the said Order and not being development comprised with any other Class\_

## SECOND SCHEDULE

ALL that piece or parcel of land comprising Ordnance Survey Parcel 0005, 5522 and part 8800 in the County of Cambridgeshire, more particularly delineated on the plan attached hereto and hereto and thereon for identification purposes only edged blue and red\_
