

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDER 1977

Direction under Article 4

The South Cambridgeshire District Council being the appropriate local planning authority is satisfied that the particular development described in Schedule 1 hereto should not be carried out in the area described in Schedule 2 hereto unless permission is granted on an application in that behalf and hereby DIRECTS that the permission granted by article 3 on the above Order shall not apply to the particular development mentioned above which development falls within class IV of the classes specified in Schedule 1 to the said Order.

The reason for making this direction is that in the opinion of the local planning authority the said particular development constitutes a treat to the amenities of their area.

The approval of this direction by the Secretary of State is not required.

This direction shall remain in force for six months from the date hereof and shall then expire unless before the termination of the said six months it has been approved by the Secretary of State.

A copy of this direction has been sent to the Secretary of State.

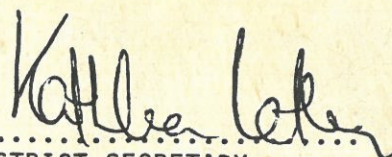
Use as a dropping zone for parachuting or sky-diving activities.

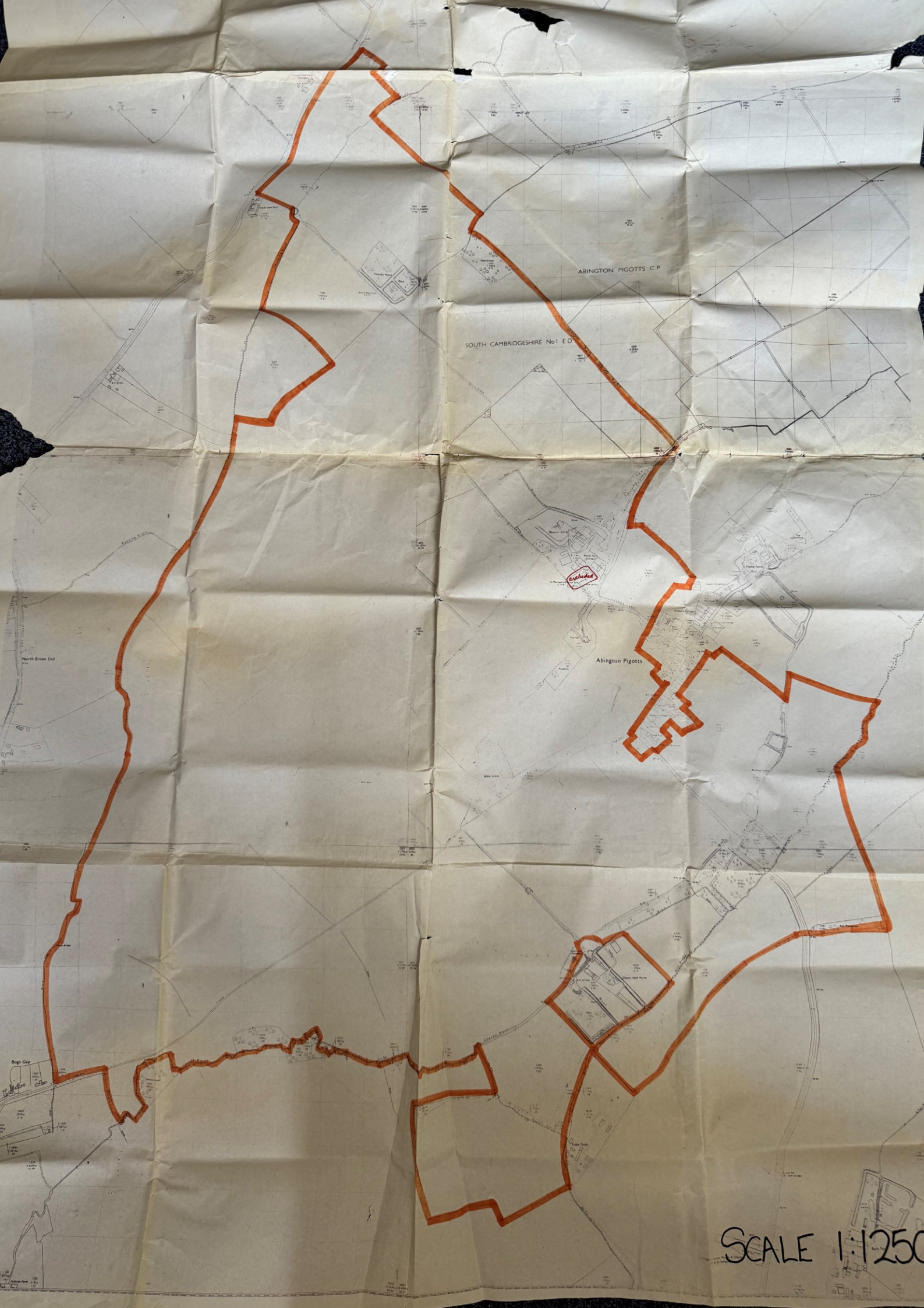
SCHEDULE e
